# PARCC Update for 3<sup>rd</sup> Graders

Our 3<sup>rd</sup> graders did a terrific job during their first testing session this past Monday. We all headed over to the Wood School where all of the PARCC testing will be done this year. The students seemed to feel comfortable with the technology and the tools needed. Teachers felt their classes handled the practice test exceptionally well.

Our upcoming days for PARCC are listed below: On the days listed we will start the testing at 9:00 and the tests run between 60 and 90 minutes per session.

Parents: On days of testing it is important to have a great night sleep, a good breakfast and get to school on time. If your child misses a testing session we will have to plan a make-up session when they return.

Dear Plainville Families,

Below you will find a Family Placement Input Form. This is an opportunity for families to share feedback on your child's learning style for the upcoming school year. Our teachers work very diligently determining the best placement for their current students. This is a process both administration and teachers take seriously. If you are interested, please feel free to add any information that you think would be important for us to know. Remember we do not take teacher requests.

We ask that you return these forms to the front office of the school your child attends by May 24th. If you normally receive a paper copy we will send one home to you, if you would like to have a paper copy sent home just let the office know and we will send one. We want to share with you a shift in this year's Step-Up Day routine. This year we will be holding a Step-Up to Your New Grade Day. During the last week of school we will have each grade take a few minutes to travel to all of the next year classrooms. This also includes 3rd grade visiting Wood School, 6th graders have already visited the middle school. The students will travel as a class and visit their "potential" classrooms. If there are five grade level classrooms they will visit each classroom for 5 minutes. This will provide the students a vision of the locations and some faces for the upcoming year.

One reason for this shift is due to the lateness of our Town Meeting (June 6th). When positions are pending on the budget approval there are often many "unknowns" at the end of the year. Unfortunately, last year we had many teachers needing to send out letters informing students they were no longer their teacher due to shifts in positions. This can be hard for our young students. There were many tears when students had to find out they were going to have a different teacher than they had met on Step-Up Day. A second reason is the logistics of the day. Previously, students would be called into line to travel into their new class, when students saw who was in line with them they sometimes shouted with joy, but this also caused many students to become upset if they didn't see their closest friends with them. We did have many tears last year during Step Up Day. Our intention is for a positive experience for our students and we feel having the anticipation of opening a letter at home with family will reach this goal best. We have amazing teachers in Plainville- students should be excited for whatever class they are assigned to. We anticipate after interviews are all done and the positions have all been confirmed, we will notify families of their child's future teacher. We will send out mail notifications 2 weeks after the end of school all homes. It will also be wonderful opportunity for you and your child to hear the exciting news of their new teacher together.
