### Eligibility for Assistance

Your child as a Military Family member is eligible for assistance if either parent meets any of the following conditions.

- Active duty members of the uniformed services, National Guard and Reserve on active duty orders.
- Members or veterans who are medically discharged, retired or deceased on active duty for (1) year.

Check if student is eligible for assistance.

- Child of active duty member of the uniformed services
- Child of member or veteran of the uniformed services who are severely injured and medically discharged or retired for a period of 1 year after medical discharge or retirement
- Child of member of the uniformed services who die on active duty or as a result of injuries sustained on active duty for a period of 1 year after death.
