







STAR Early Literacy 2015-16 Percent of Students Meeting Benchmark (60%ile) Grades K-2




STAR Early Literacy Median SGP All Students, Grades K-2




STAR Early Literacy Median SGP Students With Disabilities, Grades K-2




STAR Reading--Average Scaled Score All Students







STAR Reading 2015-16 Percent of Students Meeting Benchmark (60%ile) Grades 3-6

STAR Reading Median SGP Students with Disabilities Grades 3-6
















PARCC - MATH Scores for the District Spring 2016 Preliminary Scores – All Students




PARCC Scores for the District in ELA Spring 2015 and 2016 – All Students




PARCC Scores for the District in MATH Spring 2015 and 2016 – All Students

STUDENT WRITING GOALS IN 2015-16

<u>Kindergarten</u>

- •Goal: 80% of kindergarten students will improve their writing performance scores by 2 or more levels by the end of the 2015-16 school year.
- •Result: 100% of kindergarten students met or exceeded the 2015-16 writing goal with 28% of the students improving by 2 levels, 33% by 3 levels and 40% by 4 levels.

STUDENT WRITING GOALS IN 2015-16

Grades 1-3

- •Goal: 65% of students in grades 1-3 will improve their writing score by 5 or more points (28-point rubric) by the end of the 2015-16 school year.
- •**Result:** 52% of students in grades 1-3 met or exceeded the 2015-16 writing goal.

STUDENT WRITING GOALS IN 2015-16

Grades 4-6

- •Goal: 70% of students in grades 4-6 will improve their writing score by 5 or more points (28-point rubric) by the end of the 2015-16 school year.
- •**Result:** 77% of students in grades 4-6 met or exceeded the 2015-16 writing goal.

STUDENT MATHEMATICS GOALS IN 2015-16

Grades 1-6

•Goal: 80% of students in grades 1-6 will score 11 or higher on the 16-point Problem Solving and Perseverance Math Rubric on the June 2016 assessment at the end of the 2015-16 school year.

•**Result:** 75% of students in grades 1-6 scored 11 or higher on the June 2016 assessment.
