PERSONNEL ADJUSTMENTS IN FY2020

In order to achieve a LEVEL-FUNDED BUDGET after adopting a budget which included a 2.94% increase, the Plainville School Committee identified the following personnel reductions:

- ► Kindergarten Teaching Position
- Library/Media Specialist Position
- ➤ Part-Time Nurse Position (from 0.2 to .1 FTE)
- Occupational Therapist Assistant Position (from 1.0 from to 0.8 FTE)
- ➤ Summer Custodial Position
- ➤ Business Assistant Position (decrease by 30 days)

PERSONNEL ADJUSTMENTS IN FY2020

Upon completion of this year's annual town meeting at which time the townspeople added \$100,000 to a level-funded budget, as well as the reduction of one (1) bus and savings from one (1) teacher retirement, the Plainville School Committee has decided to reinstate the following positions:

- ► Grade 3 Teaching Position
- >0.8 FTE Library/Media Specialist Position
- >0.2 Nurse Position
- ➤ Business Assistant Position (reinstate 15 days)
- Adjust Speech/Language Assistant (SLA) and Certified Occupational Therapy Assistant (COTA) Positions to 0.83
