Pfizer-BioNTech is the vaccine approved for children 5-11. The vaccine is free for all children living in Massachusetts, regardless of insurance or immigration status. Two doses are required of the Pfizer BioN Tech vaccine. Your vaccination site will schedule your 2nd dose appointment.

Pfizer for ages 5-11 and Pfizer for 12 and up will be available. Second dose will be scheduled at the first dose appointment. **Please note that you should come masked to the location and come no more than 15 minutes before your scheduled time. Please note all those vaccinated must remain for 15 minutes following the vaccine for observation.**
