Plainville Public School - Student Device Loan Agreement

The Plainville Public School District provides school devices to students in grades K-6 to support digital learning in the classroom. During the course of the school year, school devices and chargers **may** have to be issued to students to continue to support their learning from home.

These student devices are to be used for **school-related purposes only**. All loaned devices are distributed in good working order and should be returned in good working order.

Parents/guardians are reminded that student loaned devices need to be used in accordance with the Internet Acceptable Use Policy for Students and the Parent/Student Handbook.

Parents/guardians are fully responsible for any loss or damage as well as the content the student accesses on the school loaned devices from home. Parents/guardians are expected to reimburse the school for the fair market value or cost of repair for any loss or damage to the property. Loss or theft of the property must be reported in writing to the Technology Department of the Plainville Public Schools **within 24 hours** of any occurrence through the <u>technology support form.</u>

In the event that the device should cease to function or suffer an unrecoverable error, please provide us with a brief written description of the events that occurred prior to the device's loss of function through the <u>technology support form</u>. This should be submitted when returning the device. The issue will either be addressed and the device returned to you or it will be replaced with another loaned device.

Parents/guardians are also asked to monitor the use of each school loaned device in their home as content filtering software is limited. This agreement must be completed by parents prior to being issued any district issued technology device.
