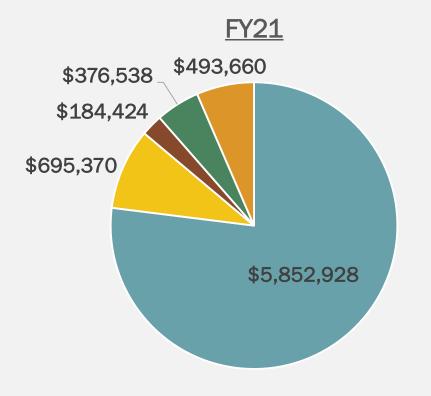

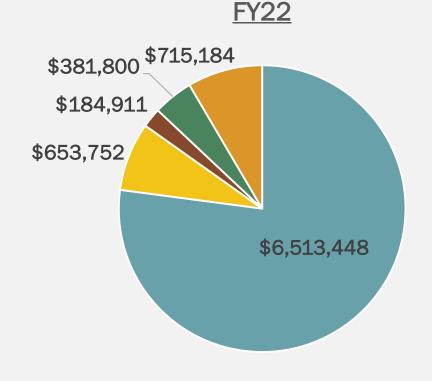
DIFFERENCE BETWEEN FY21 AND FY22
