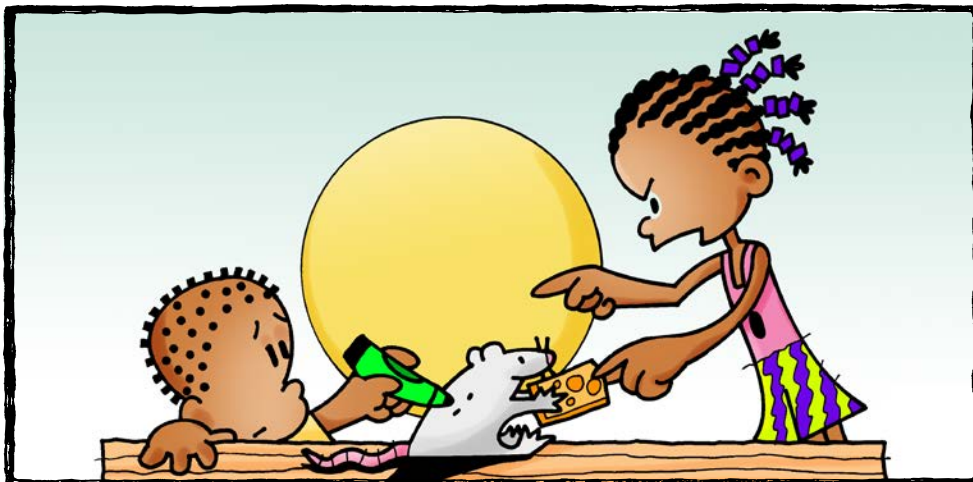

inflectional ending *-s*



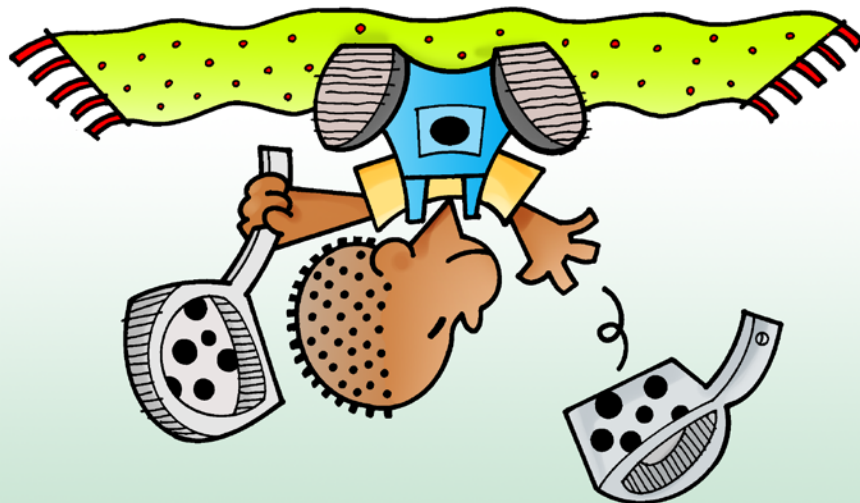

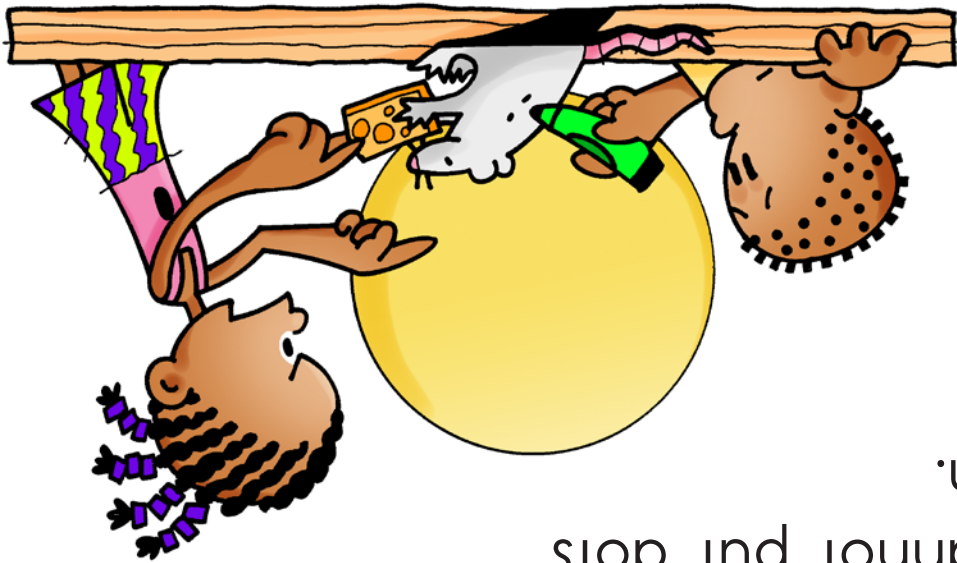

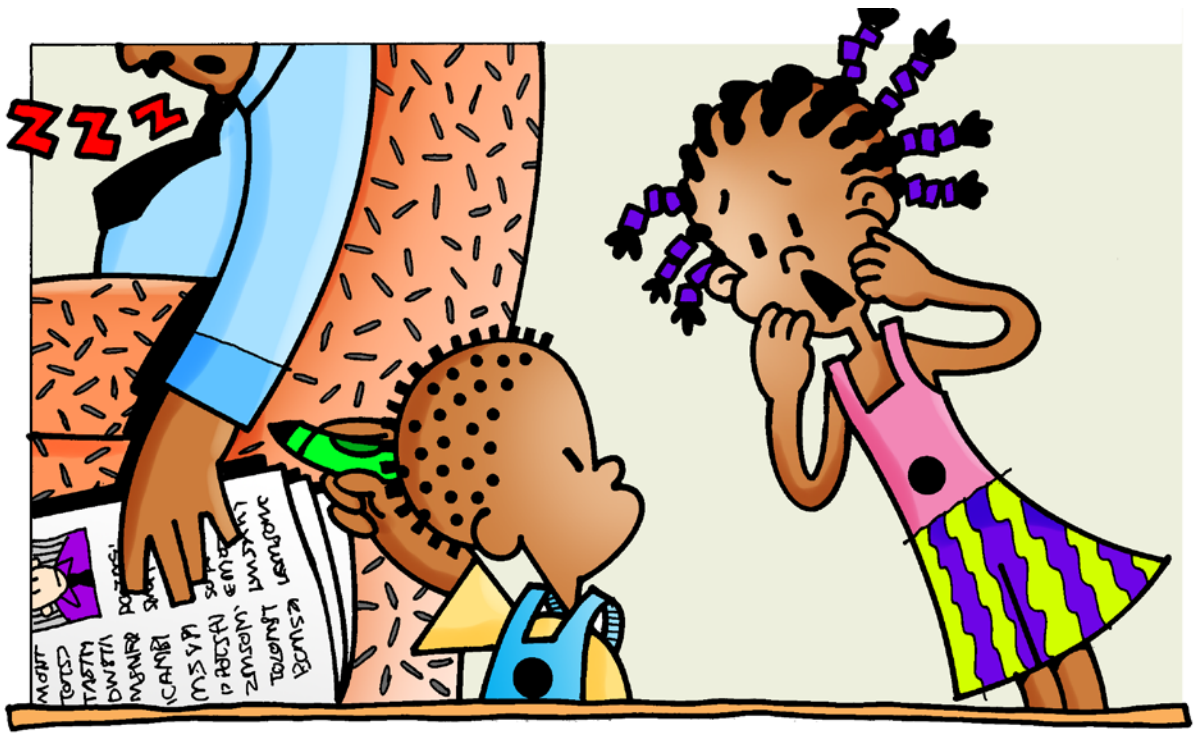
